Our curatorial mission is to relate the history, geography, and culture of the American Southwest, which includes the states of Louisiana, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado, Missouri, and Kansas. Therefore, submissions to Red River Historian Press should exhibit elements within this scope.

We accept the following types of submissions:

- Non-fiction popular works within parameters fo the curatorial mission (generally no more than 200 pages, published)
- Non-fiction scholarly treatments within parameters of the curatorial mission (generally no more than 300 pages)
- Monographs within parameters of the curaltorial mission (generally no more than 100 pages)
- Family or organization genealogies within parameters of the curatorial mission
- Transcriptions of historic journals, diaries, letters, documents within parameters of the curatorial mission
- Recipe/cookbooks/ collections within parameters of the curatorial mission
- Photography collections within parameters of the curatorial mission

We MAY accept, on a case-by-case basis:

Poetry

We DO NO accept:

- Editorials/ opinion
- Current affairs
- Fictional works, including romance, historical romance, etc.

We accept e-mailed proposals. Proposals must include:

- Your name.
- Contact information including e-mail and phone number.
- Potential Title of Book.
- Two-three paragraphs about the content of the book and how it falls within the parameters of the curatorial mission.
- Tentative outline (eg, chapter descriptions).
- Tentative schedule (eg, what has been completed, what is still needed).
- For <u>popular/scholarly/monograph submissions</u>: a current resume/CV and writing sample (e.g., a research paper, article, blog post) attached as PDF.
- For photography submissions: two original photographs, reduced image size, NO attachments.
- For recipe/cookbook submissions: one recipe, NO attachments.
